FINANCIAL REPORTS

Payment of the February 12, 2018 bills in the amount of \$132,458.76 were presented for payment from the various funds. Trustee Kinkade made a motion, with a second from Trustee Curtis to pay the bills as submitted. Roll call. All voted aye. Motion carries.

President Anderson presented the January 2018 Treasurer's Report. Trustee Curtis made a motion, with a second from Trustee Mixen to approve the January 2018 Treasurer's report as submitted. Roll call. All voted ave. Motion carries.

The following fund transfer were requested by Finance Director Austin Haacke:

\$172,291.41 from Sewer Fund (52) to Sewer Reserve Fund (33). Trustee Mixen made a motion with a second from Trustee Johnson to approve the fund transfer as presented by Finance Director Austin Haacke. Roll call. All voted aye. Motion carries.

\$14,794.00 from the Water Fund (51) to the Capital Expenditures Fund (38). Trustee Mixen made a motion with a second from Trustee Kinkade to approve the fund transfer as presented by Finance Director Austin Haacke. Roll call. All voted aye. Motion carries.

PUBLIC FORUM

Earl McCoy presented a check to the Village Police Department on behalf of LSC Communication for \$500.00 toward the K-9 Unit. He also thanked the Village for all they do for the community and LSC Communications.

Jack Weiser made a presentation to the board about his candidacy for the office of Livingston County Sheriff.

VILLAGE REPORTS

President Anderson reported to the Village that ComEd will be upgrading from analog to digital on the corner of South and Columbia.
