- 6. Comply with the Village's written and verbal recommendations regarding:
 - A. The SE/SC plan and corrections or changes made thereto.
 - B. Installation and maintenance requirements of the SM and SE/SC facilities on-site.
- 7. If any changes occur to the plans, schedules, etc., the applicant shall be responsible for notifying the Village.

Upon receipt of all required information, the SM and SE/SC plans will be reviewed within 20 working days and the applicant will be notified whether or not the plan meets technical standards.
