

Village Attorney Irv Mashing swore in the newly elected Village Clerk, Patricia Drechsel.

Village Clerk Drechsel then swore in newly elected Village President Bill Wilkey and Trustees Justin Eggenberger, Jared Anderson, and Michael Woods.

The first order of business for the new Village Board was to appoint a Village Attorney. President Wilkey asked that Gary Neville be appointed the Village Attorney for the Village of Dwight.

A motion was made by Anderson and seconded by Skinner to appoint Gary Neville as Dwight's Village Attorney. Roll call was as follows: Skinner-aye; Airgood-no; Curtis-no; Woods-no; Eggenberger-aye; Anderson-aye; Wilkey-aye. Motion carried 4 – 3.

President Wilkey brought up the issue of the property at 322 S. Franklin St., Dwight, and thought something should be done about it soon. Chief Tim Henson said he had been in contact with the Property Preservation Department to let them know what needed to be done to get the property cleaned up. A mortgage company bought the property back in February, but a judge still has to approve the sale. Henson said they were awaiting an emergency order to allow the property to be cleaned.

Wilkey said the Village needs to move forward with this issue and have Attorney Neville get a judge's order to allow the Village to clean it up, to at least get the pool pumped down.

There being no further business, a motion to adjourn was made by Skinner and seconded by Airgood. Roll call was as follows: Skinner-aye; Airgood-aye; Curtis-aye; Woods-aye; Eggenberger-aye; Anderson-aye. Motion carried 6-0. The meeting adjourned at 6:45 p.m.
